CBCA Standard of Conduct

As a church-school, we believe that to provide a quality Christian Education, a Biblical based environment should be maintained to produce physical, mental and spiritual growth of the student. Thus the following Biblical standards must be agreed to by all the students of the school.

1. Refrain from cheating, swearing, smoking, using indecent language, gambling, consuming intoxicating beverages or substances, listening to flesh-honoring music, inappropriate dancing and being entertained by indecent materials (audio or visual, paper or web).
2. Maintain Christian virtues of courtesy, kindness, morality and honesty.
3. Prohibited at the school are:
 - a. Tobacco, alcohol and non-prescription pharmaceutical products
 - b. Weapons: Knives, guns, martial arts devices, etc.
 - c. Entertainment items: TV, videos, electronic games, playing cards
 - d. Non Administration approved publications: physical or electronic
 - e. Hazardous materials (flammables, explosives, etc.) unless pre-approved for education purposes and controlled by Staff or Administration
4. Modesty: All students must maintain a modest appearance at all times while on school property (before, during and after school, including school PTF meetings and activities). Modesty includes hair and dress standards as defined in the Student Handbook. Parents and family members are also requested to follow these guidelines while participating in school functions.
5. Respect for authority: Students must show proper respect to teachers, administration or any other adult on the premises or involved in a school function. A rebellious and uncooperative spirit will not be tolerated.
